
3. Look beyond the <u>temporary</u> to see the <u>eternal</u>. (vs 20-26)

Lesson: Looking upward always helps.

4. Look beyond <u>self</u> to see God's <u>purpose</u>. (vs. 21-24)

Lesson: The secret of Joy: <u>Jesus</u> first, <u>others</u> second, <u>yourself</u> last.

He created us, and we belong to him; we are his people, the sheep in his pasture. Be thankful and praise the Lord as you enter his temple. The Lord is good! Pursuit: an attempt to find, achieve, or get something over a period of time

1. Look beyond the <u>circumstances</u> to see God's results. (vs. 12-14)

Lesson: God is <u>working</u> even when I have <u>problems.</u>

2. Look beyond the <u>trivial</u> to see the <u>important.</u> (vs. 15-18)

Lesson: <u>Focus</u> on what really counts.
