Ice Breaker: If you could have any famous figure at your Thanksgiving table (Dead or alive), who would you choose?

Read Together: Matthew 5:1 (ESV), Matthew 5:17 (ESV), Matthew 5:18-20 (ESV), Matthew 23:25-26 (NIV), Matthew 23:27-28 (NIV)

Discuss:

- > Does your righteousness exceed that of the Scribes and Pharisees?
- > What point was Jesus trying to get across when he talked about the cup and the dish?
- What was the point of the Law of Moses?

Read Together: Matthew 5:21-22 (ESV), Matthew 5:27-28(NIV) **Discuss:**

- Why do you think Jesus takes the commands of the law and bumps them up a notch? He comes back around to show us that our self-righteousness is empty.
- > What is Jesus trying to get our focus to be on?
- A person's right standing with God will never be achieved by what they DO!! Is this frustrating or freeing for you?

Read Together: John 1:12-13(NLT), 2 Corinthian 5:21 (NIV), Philippians 3:9 (NIV) **Discuss:**

- What is the requirement for being right with God?
- > When Jesus took our sin, what happened to our Identity?
- > The righteousness that comes from God is based on what?
- > We are functionally sinful at times, but what is our positional identity?
- Who gives us our righteousness?
- Everything from the beginning was working toward the reality of Jesus's coming. God's plan has always been to set all men free!! Let that sink in for a few minutes, and share any thoughts with your group!
- We must be MADE righteous; we cannot ACHIEVE righteousness. How do you see yourself in God's Kingdom?
