What Happened to the "On Fire" Believers?

As we read about the failing church in America, our hearts weep over a country that was once a vital representative of God's blessing. Many are leaving churches disenchanted. Why, we ask?

What has happened to the God-fearing believers that were once on fire for the things of God?

A recent Barna poll divides Americans into four religious categories, measuring their percentages of the American population:

- Evangelical Christians (6 percent)
- Non-evangelical born-again Christians (25 percent)
- Notional or Mythical Christians (42 percent)
- Adherents of non-Christian faiths (6 percent)
- Religious skeptics (23 percent)

The second group, a full 25%, include people who claim to be born again, but shockingly, according to Barna,

- 1. They do not believe all Scripture is inspired of God.
- 2. They do not believe in the existence of Satan as a real being.
- 3. They do not believe that Jesus lived a sinless life and that salvation is only through Him, but that other religions also lead to God.
- 4. They do not believe it is their personal responsibility to share their faith.

If Barna's research is accurate, this is alarming. But what about the Father's heart? In studying Hebrew and Aramaic words about the heart of God, we have come to understand in part the pain of the Father's heart over the world's condition.

A question in our own hearts is, Who is doing personal discipleship with the new believer or with those who have lost or who never have known the passion? O Lord, help us!

A Testimony of Hope House
