India has the highest number of children stunted because of malnutrition (48.2%), according to Save the Children's 'Stolen Childhoods' report. In 2017, Global Hunger Index (GHI) report ranked India among 118 countries with a serious hunger problem. It is an established fact that only well-nourished children can grow to their full potential, but the number of malnourished children in India is growing year after year. TellAsia Ministries' work is clearly visible to the people in remote villages of north India. We have around 125 Rural Education Centers which play a vital role in helping underprivileged families who are unable to send their children to good schools. The teachers at our centers are working hard at helping children progress in their learning.

Sunita is an example of a child helped by our education centers. Her parents never expected that this small education center would make their daughter's education dream come true. The local school in their remote village in north India is very poor quality, and Sunita was not learning even how to read or write. Her

father is a taxi driver who works day and night and her mother is a house wife and is illiterate. Sunita's father works very hard but still cannot afford to send his daughter away to an expensive boarding school. Now because of the education center, Sunita can read, write, and do basic math. Her parents are very thankful. Her father says, "Only because of this provision of free education my daughter won't have to suffer in poverty like we do now. For me it is a dream come true to see my children getting good education."
