Tips on Remaining Anchored in Eternity

Pray to God – Read His Word - Fellowship with His people.

Read Together: Ephesians 3:14-21 (ESV)

Discuss:

> To whom will you share what God is speaking to you this week?

Pray: Pray together as a group, that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have the strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.
